However, roughly 10 percent earned \$8.12 an hour or less, and 10 percent earned at least \$16.57 an hour. Data released by the BLS show that as of May 2011, ambulance drivers received the highest wages in Massachusetts, where the average wage was \$15.74 per hour. Arkansas and New York were the second and third best states for ambulance drivers, reporting an average wage of \$14.62 and \$13.81 per hour. In California, the average hourly wage was \$13.42 and in Arizona it was \$13.01. According to O-Net Online, 85 percent of those in the profession have graduated from high school or received an equivalent diploma. Approximately 10 per cent of them attended college without a diploma; only 5 percent have less than a high school diploma. However, some states or employers may require a special license for ambulance drivers or the successful completion of an emergency medical training program. Most states require ambulance drivers to pass the National Registry of Emergency Medical Equipment exam. Necessary courses are available through junior or community colleges, and local health facilities sometimes offer tuition as well. Ambulance drivers are not always licensed by paramedics or ambulances. Becoming an ambulance or paramedic requires more training and licensing than is necessary to be an ambulance driver. An aspiring ambulance must be a high school graduate and certified in cardiopulmonary resuscitation before applying for most formal training programs. To become a paramedic, applicants must successfully pass basic, intermediate and advanced training in emergency care.
