Yellowstone season 2 episode 1

The fifth season of *The Office* begins with Pam at art school in New York, Ryan returning to Dadder-Mifflin, Dwight and Angela having an affair behind Andy's back, and Michael meeting the obvious woman of his dreams in Holly's new human resources head. Pam finally comes back from art school, gets engaged to Jim and gets pregnant, while Holly and Michael enjoy a brief but intense relationship before she is transported out of town. Angela's breaking up with both Andy and Dwight, and all three end up alone. After being disrespected by a new vice president, Michael quits Dundader-Mifflin to start his own company, but returns triumphantly when he gets bought out and his opponent is banished from Scranton. Title: Weight LossOriginal Airdate: September 25, 2008 During the eight weeks over the summer, Dundader-Mifflin employees join a company throughout the weight loss challenge, which inspires Kelly to anorexia and Dwight to new levels of repulsiveness. Meanwhile, Pam heads off to art school in New York, and the breakup inspires Jim to propose to her at a rest stop (she says yes). Michael and Holly continue to flirt even as he goes on a few dates with a yoga instructor, and Dwight and Angela continue their illicit relationship, while Andy unconsciously plans his and Angela's wedding to her impossible standards. Ryan returns to Dundader-Mifflin as a temporary, filling in for Pam at the reception, and Michael seems to be the only person happy to see him. Title: Business EthicsOriginal Airdate: October 9, 2008 Thanks to ryan's scandal in corporate, Holly has to conduct a business ethics seminar for the office. Michael encourages everyone to confess their ethical transgressions, which leads to Meredith admitting that he regularly sleeps with a seller to get a discount on commissions and free Outback Steakhouse vouchers. Holly decides that Meredith should be terminated for this offense, and she and Michael have a tense meal in which he tries to convince her otherwise. Eventually, HR in corporate orders the case is wiped under the carpet. Meanwhile, Jim and Pam announce their engagement to their colleagues, who respond with general indifference. Title: Baby ShowerOriginal Airdate: October 16, 2008 Michael is planning a baby shower for January, despite not being the father of her baby. She already appears having given birth, toting along with her newborn daughter Astrid. The rather pathetic shower goes ahead anyway, with Michael treating Holly with malice, so as not to upset Jan. Michael feels no connection to baby Astrid when he holds her, but when Jan tells him not to date Holly, he goes back to the office and Holly instead; I'm sure they have something to do with it, and she agrees to go out with him. Jim and Pam spend the day having trouble connecting to each other over the phone. Title: Crime AidOriginal Airdate: October 23, 2008 Michael and Holly leave the office door unlocked after a tryst after hours, and Dadder-Mifflin is robbed. In order to be re-emerged, Michael stages a charity auction with some seriously lame items, including a pair of Bruce Springsteen tickets that don't really exist. Dwight freaks out with Angela and Andy giving a date for their wedding, and he follows Phyllis' advice to give Angela an ultimatum, but Angela doesn't answer. Jim becomes paranoid about what Pam can do in New York without him, but stops off from driving out there to check on her. Title: Transportation Official Initial Airdate: October 30, 2008 After the corporate discovers that Holly and Michael are dating, they transport Holly back to New Hampshire. On the way from Scranton, she decides that a long-distance relationship with Michael wouldn't work, and although he begs her to reconsider, they break up. To mess with Andy, Dwight decides to become a huge Cornell devotee, storing up the school's memorabilia and even sending in an application. Jim and Pam have lunch in New York with Jim's brothers, who play a bizarre prank that involves downplaying Pam's ambitions to become an artist, but she aggravates herself to them by playing along with this rather cruel trick. Title: Customer SurveyArchal Airdate: November 6, 2008 Annual Customer Service Surveys come in, and Jim and Dwight both have negative reports. It turns out that Kelly falsified the results to get back to them for not coming to her finale party. Michael discovers, but instead of reprimanding Kelly he commiserates with her for the difficulty of persuading colleagues to attend social gatherings. Andy and Angela agree to have their wedding at Schruete Farms, which gives Dwight another chance to try to flirt with Angela back. Pam and Jim spend all day on the phone together thanks to tiny headphones, so Jim listens when one of Pam's friends at art school tries to convince her to stay in New York. Title: Business TripOriginal Airdate: November 13, 2008 Michael, Andy, and Oscar take a business trip to Winnipeg to meet with a client. Michael hooks up with a doorman to try to forget his grief over Holly, while Andy tries to play a wingman for an Oscar and ends up drunk-calling an angry Angela, who resets their relationship to first base. Pam fails one of the art-school classes, but instead of spending three months in New York to do it, she comes home to Scranton to be with Jim. Kelly and Ryan connect, but seem less than excited about the return of their relationship when it becomes clear that Darryl is by no means jealous. Title: Box TobyOriginal Airdate: November 20, 2008 Toby returns to the office from his time in Costa and Michael is extremely unhappy about it. He and Dwight conspire to fire Toby, try to sexually harass him with Pam or attack Michael and ultimately unsuccessfully incriminate him for marijuana possession using a salad bag. Ryan dumps Kelly in an extremely condescending way, which gets in the usual way of ignoring her. Jim tells Pam he bought his parents' old house for them. Them. Seems doubtful at first, but eventually tells him she loves it. Title: The Surplus Original Airdate: December 4, 2008 Oscar discovers a budget surplus to be spent by the end of the day, and the Dundader-Mifflin workers split into two factions on how it should be used: One group wants to buy a new copier, while the other wants new chairs. That brings Jim and Pam against each other when Jim supports the copier. Eventually, Michael discovers that he can get a bonus if he returns the surplus, but the staff bypasses him in favor of the chairs. Out at Schruete Farms, Dwight humiliates Andy while he goes over Andy and Angela's wedding plans, and then tricks Angela into a potentially binding wedding ceremony. Her answer is to tell Dwight off and then plant a huge, completely non-erotic kiss on Andy. Title: Moroccan ChristmasOriginal Airdate: December 11, 2008 Phyllis is planning a Moroccan themed Christmas party and is using the opportunity to bully Angela into becoming her slave, threatening to reveal Angela's affair with Dwight if Angela doesn't do what Phyllis says. Eventually, Angela refuses, and Phyllis tells the whole office - except for Andy, who's in another room and remains careless. At the party, Meredith gets drunk and sets her hair on fire, which leads Michael to stage a catastrophic operation for her, and then drag her to rehab, which proves unsuccessful. Title: DuelOriginal Airdate: January 15, 2009 Michael finally tells Andy about Angela's affair with Dwight, and Andy and Dwight agree to fight a duel to determine who wins Angela's love. Their rather pathetic face-off, with Dwight brandishing esoteric weapons and Andy pinning Dwight to his car, does not result in a winner, but each ends up so disappointed in Angela that neither wants after the duel is over. Meanwhile, Michael goes to the company, where David Wallace wants an explanation of why the Scranton branch is doing so well, but of course, Michael has no idea. Title: Prince Family PaperOriginal Airdate: January 22, 2009 David Wallace sends Michael to spy on a family rival paper company, and Michael and Dwight manage to score some serious inside information, posing as a potential client and a potential new employee, respectively. Michael is in conflict for reporting information and screwing over the friendly family that owns the company, but Dwight convinces him to be ruthless. While Michael and Dwight are gone, the rest of the office holds an elaborate debate to determine whether or not actress Hilary Swank is hot. Title: Stress ReliefOriginal Airdate: February 1, 2009 Dwight's Gradual Fire (to the lack of preparedness of the office) causes Stanley to have a heart attack, so as to reduce the stress Michael decides to keep a roast (of himself). Everyone does their best to insult Michael, and eventually, he takes it to heart. But he bounces back to his usual unconscious way, pathetically firing his colleagues himself. Jim and Pam are working on. I don't know. Pam's parents divorce, and Andy confuses their silent conversations about it for intense analysis of an in-the-show movie starring Jack Black, Cloris Leachman and Jessica Alba in a lame piece of stunt casting. Title: CircuitOriginal Airdate Lecture: February 5, 2009 Michael is invited to tour the other Dundader-Mifflin branches to talk about his strategies for sales success and takes together Pam as his assistant. In Utica, Michael's lecture is a disaster, as expected, but Pam meets a newlywed and pregnant Karen, and they both seem to put the past behind them. This inspires Michael to suggest a detour so that he can achieve closure with Holly. Back in Scranton, the new co-chairs of the Jim and Dwight Party Planning Committee have forgotten Kelly's birthday, so they're working to make amends by planning a pathetic celebration. And recently single Andy is awkwardly trying to court a non-insightful client. Title: Lecture Circuit Part 2Original Airdate: February 12, 2009 Michael and Pam take their lecture tour to Nashua to face Holly, but it turns out they are off to a retreat. Instead, Michael meets holly's new friend and melts during his lecture. Later, he finds a letter on Holly's computer that she wrote to him but never sent him, and she has Pam to read it. Pam tells Michael holly still has feelings for him. Back in Scranton, Jim and Dwight keep planning Kelly's pathetic birthday party, and eventually, they find a way to make her happy. And Angela annoys everyone with her excessive attention and love for her new cat. Title: Blood DriveOriginal Airdate: March 5, 2009 Valentine's Day makes Michael depressed about his breakup with Holly, so he organizes a mixer for all the singles in the office, and invites people from surrounding businesses. Michael hopes to reconnect with a woman he shared a moment with while giving blood, but never shows up. Non-singles Jim and Pam share a couples' meal with Phyllis and her husband Bob, which goes very well until Phyllis and Bob slip away to have sex in the bathroom, making Jim and Pam extremely uncomfortable. Title: Golden TicketOriginal Airdate: March 12, 2009 Michael comes up with the idea of introducing five Willy Wonka-esque gold tickets on random paper shipments, giving customers 10 percent discounts. But when a major client gets all five, the plan backfires, and Michael tries to get Dwight to take responsibility. Dwight does it, but he ends up taking credit when things turn around. Michael can't accept that, and in the end, no one's getting along. Meanwhile, Andy, Jim, and Pam give Kevin conflicting advice on how to approach the woman he met in the singles mixer, and eventually just ignores them and asks her to go out directly. Title: New BossOriginal Airdate: March 19, 2009 New Regional Vice President Charles Minor (Idris Elba, *The Wire*) comes to Scranton and immediately shakes things up by not tolerating any of Michael's nonsense. Seeing Michael for what. I don't know. Is a formidable administrator. Charles cancels Michael's 15th anniversary party, dissolves the party's planning committee and implements reasonable office policies. Jim, dressed in a tuxedo to take on Dwight, also ends up looking silly in front of Charles. Michael, who's tired of being undermined, goes to New York to complain to David Wallace, but even after being reassured, he decides to resign. Title: Two Weeks Original Airdate: March 26, 2009 After giving his two-week notice, Michael goofs off until he realizes he has no plans for after he leaves Dundader-Mifflin. He impulsively decides to start his own paper company and goes around the office trying to hire people for this new venture, but no one gets him onto the offer. When Charles finds out what Michael's doing, he orders Michael to leave the office immediately. After spent the whole day learning how to use the new copier and then feel unrated, Pam also impulsively quits, to join Michael in his unwise new business. Title: Dream TeamOriginal Airdate: April 9, 2009 Michael and Pam race to launch the Michael Scott Paper Company as Michael is first overwhelmed, and Pam later has serious doubts. They hire Ryan but fail to bring in Michael's former telemarketing colleague Vikram or secure seed money from Michael's grandmother's investment club. Things turn around a bit when Michael secures office space in a tiny utility room in the same building as Dundader-Mifflin. In Dadder-Mifflin, everyone tries to kiss up Charles pretending to love his favorite sport, football, which ends up backfiring for Jim. Title: The Michael Scott Paper CompanyOriginal Airdate: April 9, 2009 Michael, Pam, and Ryan have a stressful first day in their new office, where they bicker with each other, stage a pathetic pancake meal as their opening party and almost decide to give up the whole effort. By the end of the day, though, they're making a sale, and things don't look so bad. In Dadder-Mifflin, Jim continues to have trouble connecting with Charles, who asks Jim to prepare a report he is not familiar with. Dwight and Andy try out their new friendship when they compete for the new receptionist's love. Title: Heavy CompetitionOriginal Airdate: April 16, 2009 Dwight is secretly passing confidential information about Dadder-Mifflin to the Michael Scott Paper Company, but after receiving praise for his salesmanship from Charles, decides to put an end to it. He and Michael then find themselves engaged in a brutal competition to steal or retain key Even Dwight's various acts of sabotage can't stop Michael from meeting with one of Dwight's biggest clients. In Dadder-Mifflin, Jim begins messing with Andy after Andy ingests that Jim may be unhappy in his relationship with Pam. Title: BrokeOriginal Airdate: April 23, 2009 Dadder-Mifflin continues to lose customers with the Michael Scott Paper Company because Michael offers drastically discounted prices. Prices, when Michael learns that his discounted rates will leave his company bankrupt in a few weeks, he jumps at the chance for a takeover by Dundader-Mifflin, and he, Pam and Ryan all return to the company, with Pam now working as a salesman. Charles seems foolish in front of David Wallace, who relied on Dwight for Jim and leaves Scranton humiliated, with Michael back in charge. Title: Casual Friday Original Airdate: April 30, 2009 With Michael, Ryan, and Pam back in Dadder-Mifflin, there's a bit of tension as Michael assigns Ryan and Pam all the customers they stole while at the Michael Scott Paper Company. The other vendors (except Jim, who stays out of it with Creed) almost stage a coup, and Michael ends up giving them their clients back. That leaves only enough customers for one more salesman, so Ryan's downgraded back to his old job. Meanwhile, a number of employees go too far with the slack of the occasional Friday, and Toby decides to shut it down. Title: Café DiscoOriginal Airdate: May 7, 2009 Michael creates a stereo and an espresso machine in michael scott paper company's empty office and tries to entice staff to join him for coffee and dancing. At first, she finds it hard to convince people, and Phyllis hurts her when she's the only one to follow him. But then Kelly and new receptionist Erin start things off, and soon the whole office dances all day away. Pam and Jim plan to sneak away for a quick wedding, but while dancing, they realize they really want a big party for their wedding. Title: Company PicnicOriginal Airdate: May 14, 2009 At the annual Dundader-Mifflin picnic company, Michael runs into Holly and her new boyfriend. Michael and Andy team up for an awesome Slumdog Millionaire parody sketch about the story of Dadder-Mifflin, during which they accidentally reveal the closure of the Buffalo branch. They don't rekindle their romance, but they share some important moments, which makes Michael happy. Jim and Pam get involved in the volleyball tournament, which highlights Jim's renewed rivalry with Charles Minor. A minor injury sends Pam to the hospital, where she discovers she's pregnant.
